## GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Apply in mid winter when trees or vines are dormant. Spray coverage; A liberal application of the product is required to ensure complete coverage of all eggs.

## MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

Pour the required amount of water into the mixing tank and while agitating, add the required amount of BioAAid Winter Oil. When using in combination with other pesticides, mix the pesticide first according to the manufacturers' instructions, then add BioAAid Winter Oil last. Maintain continuous agitation while spraying.

## PROTECTION OF LIVESTOCK, FISH, CRUSTACEANS AND ENVIRONMENT:

DO NOT contaminate streams, rivers or waterways with chemical or used containers.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Store in the closed, original container in a cool, well-ventilated area.

Do not store for prolonged periods in direct sunlight.

Triple-rinse containers before disposal. Add rinsings to spray tank.

Do not dispose of undiluted chemicals on site. If recycling, replace cap and return clean containers to recycler or designated collection point. If not recycling, break, crush or puncture and deliver empty packaging to an approved waste management facility. If an approved waste management facility is not available, bury the empty packaging 500 mm below the surface in a disposal pit specifically marked and set up for this purpose, clear of waterways, desirable vegetation and tree roots, in compliance with relevant local, state or territory government regulations. Do not burn empty containers or product.

**For 1000L containers** – Empty contents fully into application equipment. Close all valves and return to the point of supply for refill or storage.

In the event of spillage, absorb onto sand or chemical adsorbent. Remove residue with detergent and hot water. Dispose of by normal waste disposal methods conforming to local authority codes.
